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CO-LECTURING

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DEFINITION

A course is co-taught by one ASU faculty member and one or several faculty members from a Cintana Alliance institution.

The ASU Faculty delivers two hours of synchronous lectures or class sessions per week for the duration of the semester (15 weeks) in coordination with the local faculty member(s).



Weekly lectures by an ASU faculty, supported by the local faculty responsible for the course.



Flexible time allocation according to faculty's availability and institutional needs.

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ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Division of roles for lecturers

ASU lecturer

ASU lecturer should mentor the faculty from the Cintana Alliance institution, lecture to the local students, and collaborate with the local institution's team to ensure the lecture content is aligned with the class learning progression and pacing.

Local institution lecturer

Local institution lecturer should do all the student assessment, grading, lead discussion groups, oversee labs, and provide supplementary lectures.

PAYMENT

Cintana will invoice each Institution directly and each institution will make their payment via wire transfer.
